Omae Gwangju's 'Omae' is commonly used as an exclamation indicating surprise in Jeolla-do. In addition, the Korean word for Omaebulmang means 'always asleep or awake', which means longing.

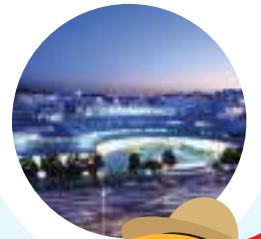

ASIA CULTURE CENTER

Asia Culture Center(ACC) has been selected as South Korea's representative tourist attraction for the second consecutive time, which is a must-visit for both domestic and foreign tourists. The ACC has been listed in the '2023-2024 South Korea's Tourist Attractions Top 100' by the Korea Tourism Organization, following the '2021-2022 South Korea's Tourist Attractions Top 100'. As the world's largest complex cultural space, the center holds lots of activities such as Asian cultural exchanges, cultural resource collection and research, content creation and production, exhibitions, and performances. The symbolic architectural style of the ground park is based on Gwangju's theme of Light and Forest. With the special design, the park is a playground where you can experience, learn and enjoy the Asian culture from various facilities such as exhibitions, performances, and libraries. The center was selected as Gwangju Unique Venue in 2021, and facilities such as the Center for ACC Culture Exchange, ACC Archive & Research, ACC Creation, ACC Children, ACC Theater, Asia Plaza, and Hanul Madang have been established.

From Chungjang-ro, the must-go street for shopping, fashion, and restaurants, to the intersection of the old City Hall, where clubs and bars are full with nightlife, this area is always overflowing with liveliness and excitement. Chungjang-ro's shopping malls, restaurants, and movie theaters make the street itself the best downtown area in Gwangju. For example, the concentrated performance facilities are to hold the Memory Chungjang Festival. The old city hall intersection next to Chungjang-ro is full of youthful enthusiasm that never sleeps. Busking is held in the 'open space' of Gwangju Folly located at the intersection.

However, Gwangju Folly is contributing to urban regeneration by playing a role of both decoration and function in public space. It started as part of the Gwangju Biennale and the Design Biennale, and currently, Gwangju Folly I, II, and III are clustering and delivering strong cultural power to the old downtown area. THE SITE OF THE HISTORY OF THE MAY 18TH DEMOCRATIZATION MOVEMENT

May 18th National Cemetery

This cemetery is a historical symbol that defended democracy in South Korea. As the May 18th Deocratization Movement Records were listed on the UNESCO Memory of the World in 2011, this place has become a symbol of hope and commitment for the future beyond anger and sadness from the tragic event. There are May 18th People's Uprising Memorial Tower that represents 'hope' and the revival of the Gwangju uprising, the video screening and exhibition hall. You can also visit Seungmoru Pavilion, Yuyeong's Enshrinement House, which commemorates the victims of May 18th, and more.

Old Jeonnam Provincial Office & Democracy Square Plaza

The old Jeonnam Provincial Office was the last battleground for the Gwangju Uprising, and it is now where you can see arts that combine The May 18th Deocratization Movement and media here. Democracy Square is a place where the will to fight was burned with the fountain as a podium.

Jeonil Building 245

Jeonil Building 245, which is almost the only place that retains its old appearance in the area of Geumnam-ro, let the world know the historical tragic event that happened during the May 18th Democratization Movement once again when the 245 bullet marks were discovered. At the Jeonil Archive on the first floor, visitors can check the history and photo data of the Jeonil Building from its first completion in 1968 to its remodeling in 2020, and you can experience helicopter shooting during the May 18th Deocratization in 1980 Using AR or Through. On the 2nd floor, there is the Namdo Tourism Center, where you can access various art products. Lastly, there are a digital information library and citizen gallery, as well as exhibition and experience spaces such as bullet marks preservation section, Moon lounge & stand on the 3rd floor.

Located in the old Gwangju Catholic Center, the archives collect and preserve the May 18th Deocratization Movement Records listed as UNESCO Memory of the World. The 1st to 3rd floors are main exhibition halls, and the restored classroom of Archbishop Yun Gong-hee is on the 6th floor.

TRACES OF 100 YEARS OF MODERN AND CONTEMPORARY HISTORY

Yangnim History and Culture Village

Yangnim History and Culture Village is where Korea and the West, Confucianism and Christianity, and tradition and modernity coexist. The village is also called the prototype of Gwangju, and the House of Yi Jang-u and the House of Choe Seung-hyo are famous places to visit.

It is also a pilgrimage resort honoring the dedication of missionaries. You can see their traces and Western-style buildings at the House of Missionary Willson, Owen Memorial Hall, and Yangnim-dong Missionary Cemetery. The village also produced outstanding writers, poets, and musicians, including poet Kim Hyeon-seung and composer Jeong Yul-seong.

It is recommended to visit the Yangnim Visitor Center next to the Yangnim-dong tourist information center and explore the village with a tour guide. Starting from Yangnim Ogeori (five-way intersection), there are cafes and restaurants everywhere.



Penguin Village Craft Street

The junk art village, where waste products have been transformed into works of art. The name came from the waddling walks, like a penguin, of elderly people with uncomfortable knees living in the village.

If you follow the signpost next to the Yangnim-dong Administrative Welfare Center and enter the narrow alleyway, you will see the old town transformed into a unique exhibition hall.

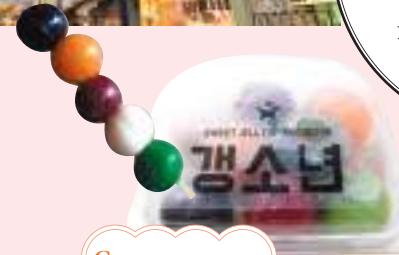

Mudeungsan National Park, designated as a national geopark and UNESCO Global Geopark, is located downtown Gwangju where many people visit every season.

Mudeungsan National Park contains everything about Gwangju. For example, Columnar Joints which is called the stone pillars of God, Gwangju Cultural Heritage No. 1 Millennium-old Temple Jeungsimsa, the lyrics culture embedding the atmosphere of lyrics literature of the Joseon Dynasty, the Unrim-dong Art Museum with the spirit of arts, and Wonhyosa Temple located in the mountains of Wonhyo Valley.

In addition, you can taste turquoise-color Mudeungsan watermelon and Mudeungsan Boribap, known as simple yet healthy food.

A historical relic of the Joseon Dynasty that is created in Lake Eco Park. Here, you can feel the traces of ancestors who wrote in harmony with nature. Even in South Korea, it is rare to see the clustered hermitage gardens of the Confucianists who loved Gasa Literature. The first garden in The Gasa Literature Collection, Soswaewon, was created by Confucianist Yang San-bo in the 16th century. He built this beautiful place to live in the peaceful nature of his hometown, after the tragic execution of his teacher Jeongam Jo Gwang-jo, who was a Confucianist and politician. Near Soswaewon, Hwanbyeokdang pavilion where Confucian scholars studied in the past, and Sikyeongjeong, meaning "A pavilion where the shadow is taking a rest". In addition, several Nujeongs are gathered here. Visiting the Korea Gasa Literature Collection is also recommended, as it has literary works.

REPRESENTATIVE TEMPLES OF GWANGJU



Jeungsimsa Temple

A representative thousand-year-old temple in Gwangju, located near the Gwangju Traditional Culture Center. It was founded by Cheolgam Preceptor in the 4th year of King Heonan of Silla (860). Inside the temple, Iron Seated Vairocana Buddha (Treasure No. 131) and Stone Standing Bodhisattva are preserved. Temple stay is also possible, and it is about a 22-minute walk from the last stop of Jeungsim Temple Bus Stop.

CONFUCIAN ACADEMY CULTURAL HERITAGE



Wolbong Confucian Academy

A place to commemorate the learning and virtue of the Confucian scholar Ki Daeseung. Spring and Autumn Festival is held here every year. It was once damaged by Daewongun's decree to abolish Confucian Academy, but starting with Bingwoldang in 1938, the shrine, Oesammun, Jangpangak, and Naesammun, were built until 1981.

It is notable that it has been built one by one over decades. Wolbongseowon Confucian Academy operates various educational and cultural programs, including learning philosophy through play and art along with experiencing the day of Joseon scholars.

Gwangjuhyanggyo Local Confucian School

Located in Gwangju Park as an educational institution, this Confucian School enlightened the people and refined customs during the Joseon Dynasty. Continuing the tradition of the Eastern Courtesy Country, it provides various educational programs such as Confucian scriptures, calligraphy, Chinese, the four ceremonial occasions, and study abroad universities.

It was designated as Tangible Cultural Property No. 9 of Gwangju Metropolitan City, and existing buildings include Daeseongjeon Hall, Myeongryundang Lecture Hall, Dongmu, Seomu, Dongjae, Seojae, Naesammun, and Oesammun Monument.

Heebyeongru

It is a representative pavilion in the Honam region built on the old site of Gongbukru by Ahn Cheol-seok, the governor of Mujin-gun (Gwangju City's old name), from 1450 to 1451, the first year of King Munjong of the Joseon Dynasty. To commemorate the promotion and restoration of Mujin-gun to Gwangju-mok back then (now Gwangju city), it was built with the name 'Heebyeong (喜慶)' with the meaning of 'rejoice together and congratulate each other' and rebuilt in Gwangju Park about 100 years after destroyed.

Mangwijeong Pavilion

This pavilion was built in the 19th century by Hyowudang (孝友堂) Jang Chang-woo to teach his students, after he moved from Namwon, Jeollabuk-do to Dongha, Seo-gu, Gwangju. Because the natural scenery near Mangwijeong Pavilion is beautiful in all four seasons, poets and scholars of the time came to write poems. Now in spring, this place has become a famous Gwangju cherry blossoms spot.

Chungjangsa Shrine
